1. Frisbee Golf Course

Supervisor DePasquale stated that Scott Kirby is in attendance tonight to address the Town Board about finishing up the Frisbee Golf Course. With that said Jim wanted Town Highway Superintendent Wohlhueter and Kayla Brautlacht the Parks department to be an attendance as well so that everyone was on the same page for the completion of the course. Scott has mowed around seven of the holes already the other two are still too wet. Any work left to be completed up there will not affect soccer or summer programs. There are some signs up on the course, but more permanent ones will be placed. Moving forward the first nine need baskets to be completed before moving on to the next nine baskets.

There was discussion on the possible ways to construct the T-Pads.

1. Boxes with just layers of stone,
2. Boxes with Pavers, stones, and possible adding turf.
3. Poured concrete pads, with that said it would be near impossible to have a concrete truck get up in the park to pour the pads. There was discussion about making forms and making concrete pads offsite and then bringing them up to the park and placing them that way. It would be a challenging way of doing the pads this way might not be practical.

Ultimately Scott, Lee and Kayla would make the choice on what would be the most practical way to make the T-Pads.

The signage was discussed with the end plan being Chris from Richard-Cin making the backs of the signs out of metal and having Greg Culver design the vinyl sign covers to fit on the metal. The vinyl covering would have the outlay of the course with a QR Code added.

The next nine would be started with the land being cleared from trees and shrubs along the course, Nathan Boldt would probably be needed again to help clear the area. Scott would than place the other nine baskets and move forward with the T-Pads and signs for the additional nine baskets. After which it would just be simple mowing up on the course. Kayla was asked if she would need help with the mowing once complete, she stated that she would be fine to work on her own. Town Board discussed having Scott come on as a seasonal worker at a rate of \$17.00 an hour for 20 hours a week. Scott also asked if he could work it out that the town could pay him for the rental of his tractor and equipment.

Scott stated that he would donate his time for the next mowing around the area and then he would reach out to the town for a proposal to moving forward. The town highway department will plan on working with him hopefully after the Fourth of July to start on the culvert pipe needed in the one area and the T-Pads well.
