Bids submitted by fax or email will not be accepted.

A **pre-bid conference** will be held for this project on May 15, 2024, 10:00 A.M..

Only written Requests For Information (RFI) will be accepted. RFI's will be accepted until **3:00 p.m. (Local Time)** on May 01, 2024 at the office of the Engineer to the attention of John A. Schenne P.E. via email: john@schenne.com. If necessary, an Addendum will be issued by **3:00 p.m. (Local Time)** on May 1, 2024 from the office of the Engineer.

Starting **May 1, 2024** copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained **ONLY at the Office of the Engineer, Schenne & Associates 967 Luther Road East Aurora, NY 14052**, upon payment of \$25.00 for each set. Checks for Contract Documents should be made payable to the **Town of Colden**. If the documents are to be mailed, a check in the amount of \$25.00, and made payable to Town of Colden, shall also be provided. Alternatively, for shipment of Bidding Documents, Bidders can provide their UPS or FedEx shipping account number in lieu of the \$25.00 check for mailing and handling.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond from a domestic carrier licensed to do business in the State of New York in the amount of not less than five (5%) of the amount of the bid submitted.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375, which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin.

The successful bidder must be an equal opportunity employer, must meet all appropriate state and federal standards, and comply with all relevant governmental regulations.

Statement of Non-Collusion: Bidders on the contract are required to execute a non-collusive bidding certificate pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

New York State Finance Law: Bidders on the contract are required to execute a New York State Finance Law Section 139-Disclosure statement.

Security for Faithful Performance: The successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds written by firms licensed to do business in New York State, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amounts in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents.

Sales and Use of Tax Exemptions: The Town of Colden is exempt from the payment of sales and compensation use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties, on all materials, equipment, and supplies sold to the Town of Colden pursuant to this contract. Also exempt from such taxes are purchases by the Contractor and his Subcontractors of materials, equipment, and supplies to be sold to the Town of Colden pursuant to this contract, including tangible personal property to be incorporated in any structure, building, or other real property forming part of the project. These taxes are not to be included in the Bid.

All bids shall be binding for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening date. The Town of Colden reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities therein.
